Stations of the Cross During Lent

Catholic Cemeteries of Long Island has a long tradition of hosting Stations of the Cross prayer services during Lent. This year, in addition to our annual Good Friday prayer service at Cemetery of the Holy Rood, Catholic Cemeteries hosted Stations of the Cross on the first Friday of Lent in our new chapel at Queen of Peace Cemetery.

First Friday in Lent, Queen of Peace Cemetery

On Friday, February 16th, 40 people attended the inaugural Stations of the Cross service in Queen of Peace Chapel. Deacon Christopher Quinn led the congregation in prayer as they walked to each Station along the walls of the Chapel.



Good Friday, Cemetery of the Holy Rood

One of the most heavily-attended events at our cemeteries each year is the walking of the Stations of the Cross at Cemetery of the Holy Rood. Annually, hundreds of family members gather on Good Friday to commemorate Our Lord's redemptive death.



We invite all families to join us at Holy Rood this **Good Friday, March 29th at 12:00 Noon**. After opening prayers at Holy Rood Chapel, we will begin our 1.5 mile pilgrimage throughout the cemetery, stopping at each of the 14 Stations to pray and reflect. The service will conclude with final prayers and Veneration of the Cross in the Chapel. If the weather is inclement, the full service will be held in Holy Rood Chapel.

Self-Directed Stations of the Cross

Families unable to join us on Good Friday are invited to participate in a self-directed Stations of the Cross prayer service at **Cemetery of the Holy Rood** or **Queen of Peace Cemetery**. Families may come to either cemetery to complete the self-directed prayer service at a time convenient to them during Lent.

Prayer booklets for Stations of the Cross may be picked up from the Chapels at both cemeteries. Prayer booklets may also be downloaded from our website at cclongisland.org/stations-of-the-cross.

Holiday Decoration Program for 2024

Have you placed your holiday decoration orders for 2024? Families may place holiday decoration orders on our website for the following holidays: **Easter (March 2024)**, **Mother's Day (May 2024)**, and **Father's Day (June 2024)**.

See below for the decoration options available for both gravesites and our mausoleum chapels. For chapel decorations, the name of your loved one will be listed in a memorial book placed in the chapel. To begin your order, select the cemetery in which your loved one is interred to view the decoration options and add items to your cart. When ordering decorations for gravesites, please make sure to enter the correct plot location (Section-Range-Plot) of your loved one. If you are unsure of the exact grave location, please use our [Locate a Loved One search tool](#) to obtain that information.

Please note:

- If you placed an order for an annual decoration package or for individual holiday decorations for Easter/Mother's Day/Father's Day when the decoration program opened up in Fall 2023, there is no need to order for those holidays again.
- Catholic Cemeteries of Long Island reserves the right to substitute decorations of a similar quality and nature, based on vendor availability. For Mother's Day and Father's Day plants, floral color and exact mix of flowers and containers may vary.

New Columbaria and Available Options for Cremation

Last Fall, Catholic Cemeteries of Long Island announced the addition of "**Cremation Garden of Angels**" sections at **Cemetery of the Holy Rood**, **Queen of All Saints Cemetery**, and **Holy Sepulchre Cemetery**. In the first phase of each cremation garden, a new columbarium was installed with niches available for families to consider.

These new niches can accommodate **1 or 2 urns**, depending on the size of the urn. In addition to a bronze crucifix and sandblasted inscription, niche fronts may be memorialized with bronze emblems and stainless steel portraits. Each garden is dedicated to a specific Archangel:

CEMETERY OF THE HOLY ROOD IN WESTBURY

- **Saint Michael the Archangel** Cremation Garden
- Located on the northwest corner of Section 7



QUEEN OF ALL SAINTS CEMETERY IN CENTRAL ISLIP

- **Saint Gabriel the Archangel** Cremation Garden
- Located between Queen of All Saints Garden Chapel Mausoleum and Annunciation Garden Mausoleum



HOLY SEPULCHRE CEMETERY IN CORAM

- **Saint Raphael the Archangel** Cremation Garden
- Located north of Section 11 in close proximity to The Risen Christ Meditation Garden



The Cremation Garden of Angels at each location serves to expand the options for cremated remains to be committed at our Catholic Cemeteries of Long Island. **In addition to these new columbaria, families may choose the following options for cremated remains:**

- **Glass front niches** and **marble/granite niches** inside large community mausoleums
- **Granite front niches** in outdoor garden mausoleums
- Dedicated **cremation graves**
- Option of including cremated remains in all of our traditional **in-ground burial plots**

Families may select a space "**at need**" when a loved one has just passed or "**pre-need**" to lock-in their final resting spot now, relieving their loved ones of the burden to make such decisions at the time of interment. In addition, we welcome you to now bring in loved ones who were previously cremated but not yet committed and laid to rest.

Please call any of our four sites today and make an appointment to come in and explore the options to determine the one right for you and your family.

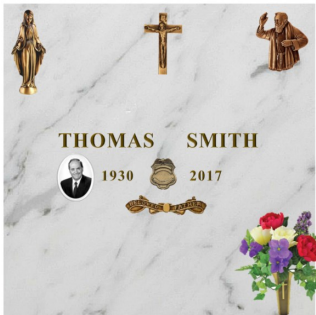

CRYPT & NICHE BRONZE EMBLEMS

CRYPT & NICHE FLORAL VASE PROGRAM

When subscribing to the **floral vase program**, Catholic Cemeteries of Long Island will supply and install an artificial floral arrangement in a vase for a crypt or niche front. CANDLE MEMORIALS

Families may purchase a candle memorial in one of our community mausoleums. Red candles may be purchased for 1 or 2 years, while white candle memorials remain lit for 2 years. [Click here](#) for information on our candle memorial program or to purchase a candle memorial online.



MONUMENT CLEANING SERVICES

A clean monument enhances the natural qualities of the granite and adds to the overall beauty of a well-kept cemetery. Our staff is knowledgeable on the cleaning products necessary to remove different types of stains.



Pricing for this service is determined by monument size. Please note that monument cleaning services are only available during the months of **May through October**. To request cleaning service on your monument, please contact the cemetery office or complete the [Maintenance Request Form](#) on our website.

SHRUB AND BUSH MAINTENANCE

A well-maintained, balanced shrub or bush enhances the natural qualities of the plant, adds to the overall beauty of the family plot and compliments the monument. With regular maintenance throughout the growing season, early detection of growth-related problems is possible. A treated bush can be saved when early detection occurs.



Pricing starts at **\$60** per shrub/bush trimmed or removed. To request service, please contact the cemetery office or complete the [Maintenance Request Form](#) on our website.

GRAVESITE BOUQUET HOLDERS

Aluminum bouquet holders are the perfect place for floral arrangements and are a lasting and beautiful memorial tribute. Available for use at most in-ground burial sites, these bouquet holders come in two parts: the holder and the insert. The insert should be inverted when not in use to prevent filling with water, which attracts breeding mosquitoes.



Bouquet holders are **\$65** and can be [purchased online](#) or at the cemetery office.
