Crypt and Niche Vase Use and Floral Agreement

This program is not available for all mausoleum spaces, please confirm with the Cemetery office if the vase program is permitted for your particular crypt or niche.

It is agreed that Catholic Cemeteries will supply and install artificial floral arrangements to be placed in a mausoleum vase located on the individual crypt or niche front (where permitted).

There will be a one-time fee for use of the bronze mausoleum vase, provided there is on-going participation in the floral placement program. **This fee includes installation and maintenance of the vase; vases are leased, not purchased.**

Placement of the vase requires consent from the original owner in the form of the presentation of the original Certificate for Right of Entombment Privilege or appropriate affidavit (can be requested from the Cemetery office).

The vase installation fee will be: **Crypt Front Vase \$260.00 Niche Front Vase \$120.00**

The vase will be removed from crypt/niche front if the floral program is not renewed by September 1st of the year it expires and a fee will be charged to reinstall the vase if requested at a later date.

The seasonal schedule is as follows:

Fall: September 1 to November 30

Spring: March 1 to May 31

Winter: December 1 to February 28

Summer: June 1 to August 31

Although we all wish to see the new flower arrangements completed on the first day of the season, the cemetery reserves the right to take up to 14 days at the start of each season to fully change floral arrangements throughout all the cemetery mausoleums.

The current yearly cost for **all four arrangements for the crypt vase program is \$130.00**, starting September 1st

The current yearly cost for **all four arrangements for the niche vase program is \$110.00**, starting September 1st

The cost of each program includes floral arrangement, installation, removal, maintenance, and administrative expenses. Floral costs are subject to change each year and multi-year renewal options are available.

Should families wish to begin the program other than September 1st, they will be charged a pro-rated cost. The placement of vase and floral piece commences the following season.

All floral arrangements will be selected by Catholic Cemeteries. Catholic Cemeteries reserves the right to substitute a floral piece of similar style due to stock shortage, discontinued product or unavailable floral supplies. The selections will reflect the seasonal changes throughout the year. Any floral arrangement that the family may wish to keep should be picked up two (2) days prior to the season ending date. A new series of arrangements will be introduced each year.

A notice will go out each July as a reminder of renewal for those vases expiring in August. These notices will include any new information on updates or changes to the program, including floral arrangements selected for the upcoming year. Families are responsible for contacting the Cemetery office with any changes to contact information to ensure these notices are received to avoid any lapse in the program.

Where approved, vases are installed on the lower right corner of a crypt or niche front. For side-by-side companion crypt fronts, two vases may be installed, one on the bottom left corner and one on the bottom right corner.

Note: 1) The cemetery's responsibility to repair and/or replace vase and floral decoration(s) shall be subject to the limitations expressed in the General Planting and Decorating Rules and regulations of the cemetery. 2) Vases governed by this program are not for sale. 3) The cemetery reserves the right to determine floral type and vase location, placement, and prices. 4) Nothing shall be affixed or attached to the vase and/or floral placement. 5) new orders received are for the first day of next season.
