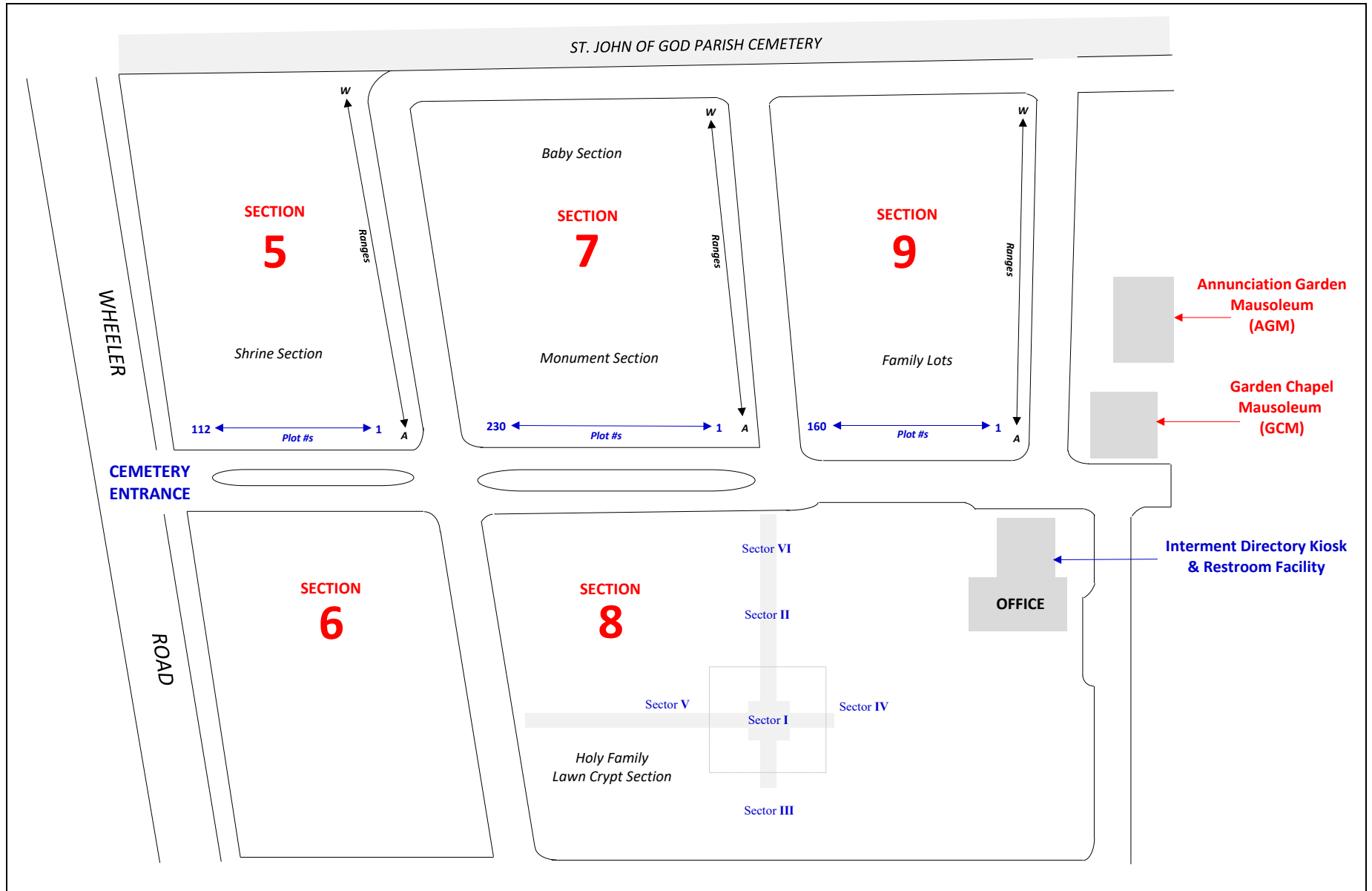

For your convenience, **cemetery gates** are open every day of the year from **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM** (*for your safety cemetery grounds are subject to closure during periods of severe inclement weather*).

Office Hours:

Monday thru Friday 9:00AM to 4:30PM
Saturdays 9:00 AM to 12 NOON

Office closed on Sundays and holidays. There are early closings for some Holy Days (visit office or website for schedule).

Community Mausoleum buildings close commencing 4:30 PM

Masses are celebrated for the repose of the souls of all those interred in Queen of All Saints Cemetery on **Memorial Day and All Souls Day**.

Masses are also celebrated **monthly on Saturday at 9:30 AM** throughout the year. Please consult the cemetery office, Sacred Places (newsletter) or website for exact dates scheduled.

Please obtain and review a copy of the current **Rules and Regulations** before **planting**. Copies are available at the cemetery office or at the website.

Reminders

- Dogs or other pets are considered inappropriate in a cemetery.
- There's a posted 20 mph Speed limit on our grounds. Please drive carefully.
- One Way – Okay! – Please follow the signs
- Park on the pavement. Never the Grass or lawn areas.
- Respect the privacy and prayerful reflection of others.
- Chapels, benches, and flower stands are meant to be shared!
- Hours are 8am to 5pm – for your safety please adhere to this schedule.
- Do not leave your car keys or any valuables in your car while visiting as the Cemetery cannot assume responsibility for lost or stolen items.
- **How to locate your family lot?**
1) Find the Section _____ Range _____ Lot _____
Name of Interred _____
of the plot from the Interment Kiosk Directory located in the office foyer.
2) Locate the Section (see Map of entire cemetery) and Range (generally a row of graves designated as A to Z followed by AA to ZZ), Note: All locations are on the right side of each monument. In most cases, even numbered lots face one direction, odd numbered lots face the opposite direction. 3) If there is no monument on the lot, the exact location may be found either by counting along the same range from an existing monument or by lining up the lot with the same number monument in adjoining rows.
- Choosing a decoration. Is it reasonable and practical? Is it appropriate in size? Is it consistent with the religious nature of a catholic cemetery? If its one of kind, leave it at home. If its too precious to part with leave it at home. If its not meant for inclement weather. Leave it at home! (Preferably indoors). Keep it: Simple, Elegant, Bio-degradable, minimal trash at time of placement and disposal. Thank you! What might be personal and special to you can be a hazard to workers or sometimes even have an offensive or hurtful meaning for other visitors.
- Plant 18" in a semi-circle in front of the monument is 18 inches no more. The width or length of the monument not the actual lot size.
