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Checklist of Items to be Presented at Cemetery Office on Day of Committal Service

- Original Cemetery Certificate (Deed) --OR-- Signed & Notarized Permit to Open Affidavit**
 - Photocopies of certificate **not acceptable**
 - If original certificate is not available, cemetery will provide a Permit to Open affidavit which must be signed and notarized

- Original Cremation Certificate**
 - Certificate usually comes in the box with the cremated remains from the crematory

- Signed & Notarized Committal Letter**
 - Affidavit provided by cemetery, to be completed by the current certificate holder or next of kin

- Payment for all cemetery fees**
 - Credit/Debit Card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover) or certified/bank check
 - American Express and personal checks are **not accepted**

- Cremated Remains in Appropriate Urn**
 - **Niches:** Review the regulations for your niche type which are specified in the printed rules signed at the time of purchase
 - **Plots:** Urns are placed in a vault prior to burial. Maximum urn size should not exceed **12.5" Long x 6" High x 7.5" Wide**
 - The standard container from crematory meets requirements **unless** remains are being inurned in a glass niche.

- Priest Lines Certificate (when required)**
 - Document from parish church or hospital chaplain confirming decedent's eligibility for burial in a Catholic cemetery
 - Certificate is required in the following scenarios:
 - Funeral liturgy was not held in a parish church
 - Funeral liturgy took place outside of the New York metropolitan dioceses
